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FEEDBACK: ACTION TAKEN REPORT (SESSION 2023-24)

(Based on the analysis of the feedback collected from various stakeholders)

Our institute has an effective mechanism in place to obtain feedback from various stakeholders and we encourage them to provide us with thoughtful and constructive feedback.

Data was collected from the stakeholders through online feedback forms, with questions regarding the curriculum, faculty, and infrastructure of the college. Responses from the data collected were then analysed and key suggestions/ concerns listed. It is our endeavour to take necessary measures to address the issues raised and efforts are made to strengthen the core areas of the college and onredressing various grievances.

KEY SUGGESTIONS/ CONCERNS/ ISSUES:

- The issue of improvement in the infrastructure and facilities was reported in the feedback.
- A need for career counselling and placement was also felt so that students gain employability skills.
- Conducting more of student centric activities was also suggested for their physical, mental, and intellectual development and to shape their personality.
- Wi-Fi connectivity on campus needs to be upgraded.

STEPS/ ACTIONS TAKEN:

- Sanction for extensive renovation of the Mata Kheevi Hostel building was granted to ensure
 the highest level of comfort and hygiene to the students and included the following repair
 and maintenance work:
 - Gazebo in the lawns
 - ii. Complete washroom renovation
 - iii. Iron mesh work for tackling monkey menace
 - iv. Tile terracing



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- Renovation for the college building was also sanctioned:
 - i. Grills on the windows in classrooms
 - ii. Plumbing and sewerage work
 - iii. Repair of washrooms
 - iv. Tile terracing- college building, auditorium, library
- Bandwidth of college wi-fi was increased from 850 to 1000 Mbps to provide seamless connectivity on the campus.
- Sanction was also granted for a water harvesting plant in the college campus, which will help to reduce flooding, recharge ground water and provide an alternative water source.
- To bridge the gap between our students' skills and the expectations of the industry, the
 Placement cell organized talks, workshops, and placement drives for the students. These
 Activities not only imparted soft skills to the students but also addressed areas such as
 Resume preparation, mock interviews, and personality development. The on-campus
 Placement drives placed several students in renowned companies.
- To enhance soft skills of students, interactive workshops were organized and Value-added course in Communication Skills was conducted by the Post Graduate Department of English.
- Several MoU's were signed to strengthen our industrial links, which also help us to work jointly for mutual benefit and growth.
- Classes were commenced in September 2023 at the GGSCW Rekhi Centre of Excellence for the Science of Happiness, which works for the mental health of students.
- Various workshops and talks by experts and professionals from the industry were organised, which are a valuable resource for students, providing practical knowledge, career guidance, and networking opportunities.



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

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

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (hereinafter referred to as "MOU") is made on 15 day of May 2023.

BY AND BETWEEN

Rekhi Foundation represented by Dr. Satinder Singh Rekhi, having its office at 2051, last Chance Court, Gold River, CA, 95670, which expression shall, where the context so admits, be deemed to include its successors, executives and administrators of the ONE PART

AND

Guru Gobind Singh College for Wumen, Sector 26 Chandigarli which expression shall, where the context so admirs, be deemed to include its soccessors, executors and administrators of the SECOND PART

WHEREAS, University propose to establish "Rekhi Centre of Excellence for the Science of Rappliness", with aim to promote research, training and education and the practice of well-being for students and reachers through the application of happiness and well-being.

WHEREAS, First Party wants to participate in this noble cause and want to spomsor certain activities under the "Rekhi Centre of Excellence for the Science of Happiness".

WHEREAS, First Party shall be represented by Dr. Satinder Singh Rekhi or his assignor.

WHEREAS, Second Party has authorized Dr. Reens Parti as Co-ordinator for correspondence and communication with Rekhi Foundation.

The two signing organizations shall be referred to as the Parties.

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ARTICLE I: MANAGEMENT

- 3.1. Guru Gobind Singh College for Women will be responsible for establishing and managing Rickin Centre of Excellence for the Science of Happiness*, project coordination, student management, finances, and the learning environment.
- Rekhi Foundation will develop and share the curriculum of happiness to Guru Gobied Singh College for Women for defevering to Students.
- Guru Gobind Singh College for Women will actively promote "Rekhi Centre of Excellence for the Science of Happiness" at major platforms for mutually agreed periods.

ARTICLE 2: SPONSORSHIP

- Initially, Rekhi Foundation shall support "Rekhi Centre of Excellence for the Science of Happiness" by sponsoring 2 (Two) faculty members who will serve as Faculty to the Centre.
- Reichi Foundation will provide a corpus amount of Rs_20 (Twenty) lacs payable in 2 (Two)
 instalments.
- Rekhi Foundation will provide Rs 15 (Fifteen) lacs for setting up a Mind Lab payable in 2 (Two) instalments.
- Rekhi Foundation will spend an amount of up Rs 20 (Twenty) lacs per annum towards the remuneration of the aforesaid Professors.
- 2.5. Rekhi Foundation will also sponsor online training programs for Guru Gobind Singh College for Women faculty to build in home expertise for up to 5 (Five) faculty members.
- 2.6. Reichi Foundation will supplement the teaching in the "Reichi Centre of Excellence for the Science of Happiness" from time to time, if required by providing trainers. If this is required on site, then travel and stay expenses will be paid by Guru Gobind Singh College for Women.
- Rekhi Foundation shall spemior up to 5 (Five) paid Internship to students on Happiness.

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ARTICLE 3: PROMOTION

- 3.1 Guru Gobind Singh College for Womeo shall create a web page for the "Rekhi Centre of Excellence for the Science of Happiness" detailing the project.
- 3.2. The Activities of the "Rekhi Centre of Excellence for the Science of Happiness" and its initiation will be promoted through social media. Commencement, details and impact of the "Rekhi Centre of Excellence for the Science of Happiness" will be displayed on the website of Guru Gobind Singh College for Women with a peeu release to this effect.
- The University will appoint Dr. Satinder Singls Rekhi as an Adjunct Faculty Member of the University to support the Science of Happiness classes.

ARTICLE 4: MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE & PERIOD OF CONSULTATIONS

4.1. The Rickit Foundation and Guru Gobind Singh College for Women will appoint representatives to manage and oversee the joint activities of the Centre. The Rickit Foundation and Guru Gobind Singh College for Women may meet as and when necessary but at least half-yearly (Physically / Vernally) to review progress in the implementation of the plans, define new areas for cooperation, and discoss matters related to the MOU.

ARTICLE 5: TERMINATION AND AMENDMENTS

- This MOU shall be in effect from the date of signing and shall remain valid unless terminated by either party for good reason.
- 5.2 Either Party may request termination of this MOU, in writing, with 90 (Ninety) days prior written notice. Any activity in progress at the time of termination shall be permitted to conclude as planted unless otherwise agreed in writing.
- 5.3. Amendments to this MOU may be requested, in writing, by either Party and approved by the uniherized signatories of both parties after due deliberations.

- 6.2. Nothing in this MOU shall be construed as creating any legal relationship between the Parties. This MOU is a statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial cooperation. Any conflict shall be managed between the parties amicably.
- 6.3. The Parties recognize that appropriate representation is important to emphasize their common interests, purposes, and intentions in substantive terms. The Parties, therefore, intend to invite each other, where appropriate, to meetings, conferences, seminars, and workshops relevant to cooperation in the priority areas set out in this MOU.

In complete agreement with the above, we, the two Parties' representatives, the Rekhi Foundation and Guru Gobind Singh College for Women, sign this MOU.
