 - A note on the contribution of the seminar to the existing body of research.
- II. The audited head-wise statement of accounts and utilization certificate in GFR (form 12A) (copy enclosed) for the entire expenditure incurred from the sanctioned amount. Both these needs to be duly certified by the Convener, Registrar/Principal, and the Finance Officer in case of the Central University or the Chartered Accountant in case of other institutions.



- Any amount of the assistance remaining unspent during the current financial year shall be refunded to the ICSSR immediately after completion of the seminar/conference. If the organization do not refund the amount in time, it will be required to refund the amount of the grant with interest thereon @ 10% per annum from the date of release of grant from ICSSR.
- As per the directives from the Government of India, all the payment are to be made by e-payments only. Kindly furnish the information in the PFMS form duly verified by the administrative head of the Institution/University & College after ensuring that the account has been linked with the ICSSR.

ARTICLE 1: MANAGEMENT

- 1.1. Guru Gobind Singh College for Women will be responsible for establishing and managing "Rekhi Centre of Excellence for the Science of Happiness", project coordination, student management, finances, and the learning environment.
- 1.2. Rekhi Foundation will develop and share the curriculum of happiness to Guru Gobind Singh College for Women for delivering to Students.
- 1.3. Guru Gobind Singh College for Women will actively promote "Rekhi Centre of Excellence for the Science of Happiness" at major platforms for mutually agreed periods.

ARTICLE 2: SPONSORSHIP

- 2.1. Initially, Rekhi Foundation shall support "Rekhi Centre of Excellence for the Science of Happiness" by sponsoring 2 (Two) faculty members who will serve as Faculty to the Centre.
- 2.2. Rekhi Foundation will provide a corpus amount of Rs_20 (Twenty) lacs payable in 2 (Two) instalments.
- 2.3. Rekhi Foundation will provide Rs 15 (Fifteen) lacs for setting up a Mind Lab payable in 2 (Two) instalments.
- 2.4. Rekhi Foundation will spend an amount of up Rs 20 (Twenty) lacs per annum towards the remuneration of the aforesaid Professors.
- 2.5. Rekhi Foundation will also sponsor online training programs for Guru Gobind Singh College for Women faculty to build in house expertise for up to 5 (Five) faculty members.
- 2.6. Rekhi Foundation will supplement the teaching in the "Rekhi Centre of Excellence for the Science of Happiness" from time to time, if required by providing trainers. If this is required on site, then travel and stay expenses will be paid by Guru Gobind Singh College for Women.

- 3.3. The University will appoint Dr. Satinder Singh Rekhi as an Adjunct Faculty Member of the University to support the Science of Happiness classes.

ARTICLE 4: MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE & PERIOD OF CONSULTATIONS

- 4.1. The Rekhi Foundation and Guru Gobind Singh College for Women will appoint representatives to manage and oversee the joint activities of the Centre. The Rekhi Foundation and Guru Gobind Singh College for Women may meet as and when necessary but at least half-yearly (Physically / Virtually) to review progress in the implementation of the plans, define new areas for cooperation, and discuss matters related to the MOU.

ARTICLE 5: TERMINATION AND AMENDMENTS

- 5.1. This MOU shall be in effect from the date of signing and shall remain valid unless terminated by either party for good reason.
- 5.2. Either Party may request termination of this MOU, in writing, with 90 (Ninety) days prior written notice. Any activity in progress at the time of termination shall be permitted to conclude as planned unless otherwise agreed in writing.
- 5.3. Amendments to this MOU may be requested, in writing, by either Party and approved by the authorized signatories of both parties after due deliberations.

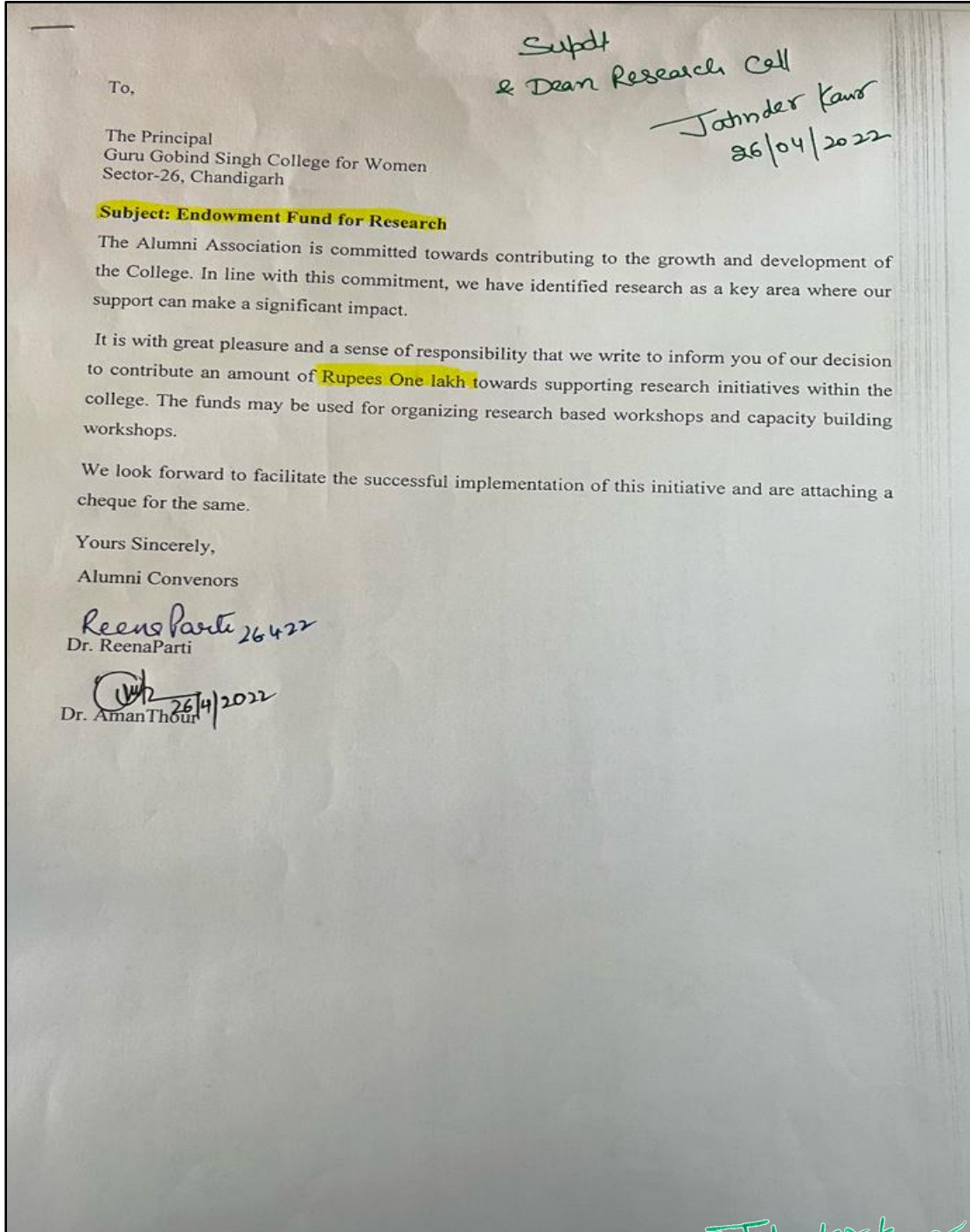
