ATR 2017-18

- In 2017-18, the college hosted the centralized online admission for B.Sc (Non-Medical) for all government and aided colleges of Panjab University.
- The IQAC streamlined the utilization of grants received under the RUSA scheme from MHRD for new construction. 30 computers have been purchased under the RUSA scheme. 10 computers are now available in the Research Lab. SPSS software was also purchased under the RUSA scheme for the benefit of students and faculty. 10 classrooms were converted into smart classrooms and 6 classrooms got interactive boards. Repair, whitewash and beautification of canteen area were also done under RUSA.
- RUSA grant was allocated for multipurpose Sports ground and up gradation of Open Air Theatre.
- The IQAC, in the session 2017-18, undertook the extensive task of preparation of NAAC SSR for Cycle 3 Accreditation. All criteria were assigned to teams under conveners who collected and collated the data. The IQAC initiated the formal process of Academic Audit for session 2016-2017.
- Teachers were motivated to publish papers, as a result of which 16 books/chapters and 58 papers were published and 15 papers were presented at the National and International levels. Number of Workshops/Seminars/conferences conducted by different departments.
- The office is now equipped with centralized software Campus Whizz which provides access to student and employee information. New software ILMS, Campus Whizz was introduced. The College Library also has a Blog ggscwlibrary.blogspot and Wall Magazine Khoj for the benefit of students. LED Display Unit was installed in Library.
- Industrial visits were arranged to familiarize students with the Industry environment.
 The Tribune was visited by Functional English students to understand the working of
 printing press. Visits were made to Old age homes, orphanages and blind schools for
 social causes.
- A Parent Teacher Meeting was held on 7.4 2018 to make the parents aware of their ward's performance in house examinations and their attendance in the classes.
- LED lights and fans, new furniture, automatic washing machines and Kota stone in the balconies were added in the hostel.
 - Efforts for Carbon neutrality by planting more trees in the campus. Tree Plantation Drive was organized to promote Clean and Green Campus on 15.9. 2017. With collaborated efforts and hard work college lawns are satiated with diverse flora, which multiplies the beauty of campus and help to enhance aesthetic sense of

students. The campus has brought laurels by winning the 2nd prize at Annual Rose Festival 2018 in the category of 'Best Maintained Campus' in Chandigarh. The Environmental Society celebrated World Forestry day on 21.3.2018 and participated in Akshay Urja Diwas sponsored by CREST, Chandigarh. Held competitions on the themes "Save Forests, Save Earth". The society also encouraged the students in Inter college competitions at Akshay Urja Diwas, Environment Conservation Fest. Rally for Rivers seminar was organized in collaboration with Isha foundation on 20.9.2017. Students participated in the Tree Walk, a Times of India initiative. Efforts were initiated to create a herbal garden in the college campus. Bulbs, Fans in the hostel were replaced with LED bulbs and Fans to conserve electricity under Pradhan Mantri Ujwal Vikas Yojna.
