• Address by the honorable Principal Dr. Jatinder Kaur, Chairperson IQAC

The Principal, Dr. Jatinder Kaur, Chairperson IQAC, welcomed the members to the first IQAC meeting of the session 2020-21, which was held online because of the ongoing Covid-19 pandemic.

• Academic & Administrative Audit

After discussion with IQAC team and the Audit Committee, the Chair recommended to incorporate certain changes in the Academic & Administrative Audit Performa because of change in the mode of teaching because of the ongoing pandemic.

• SOP's of GOI and safety measures

The Chair proposed that Discipline Committee will be renamed as Ethics & Code of Conduct Committee and a new committee should also be formed to ensure that all the safety measures are followed in the campus during the ongoing pandemic.

• Online Portal for smooth conduct of classes

Members also discussed about the available options for smoothly conducting the online classes. It was decided that the College will try to get subscription for G-suite by Google, for conducting online classes.
