

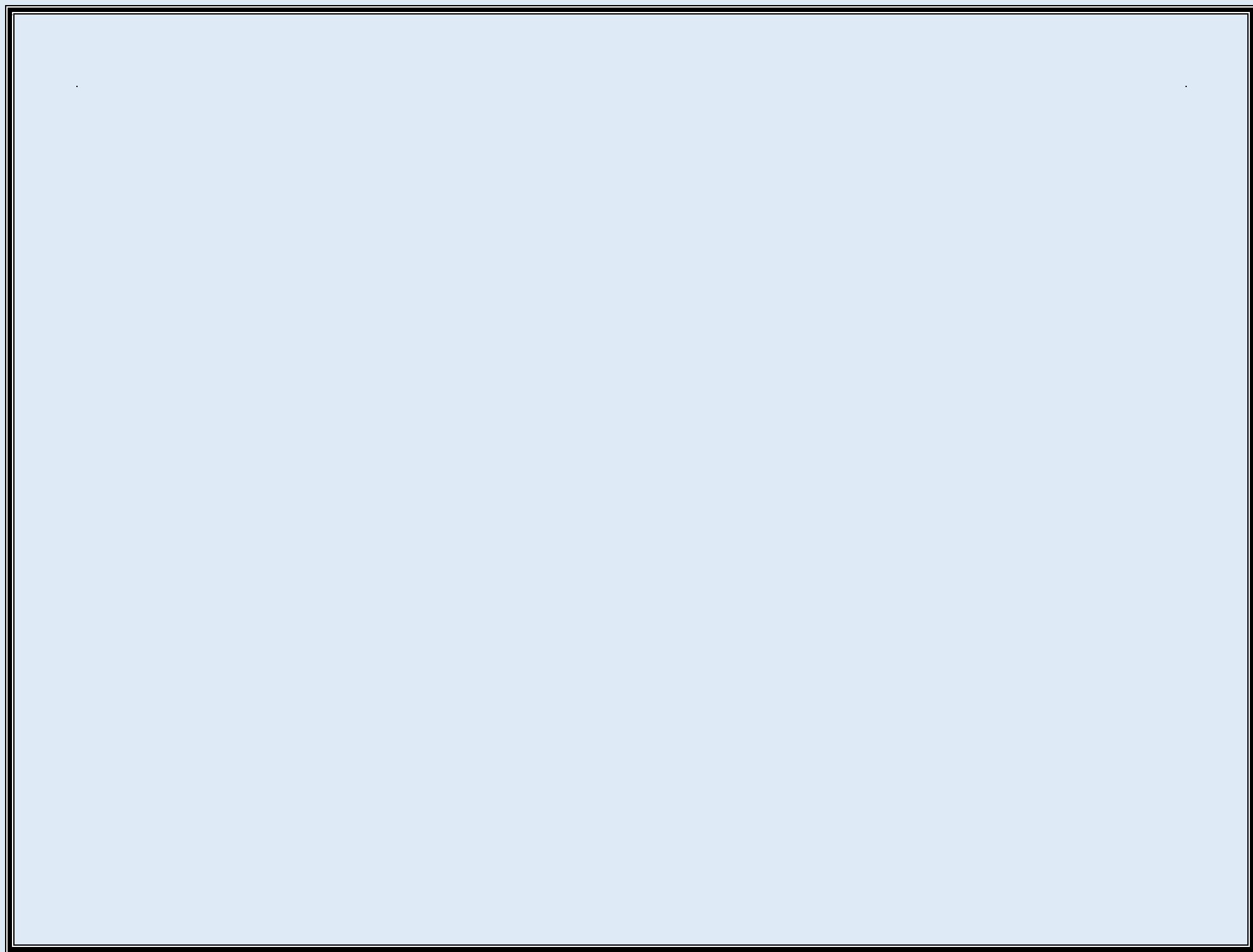

4. Citizens' Rights

Subject- Political Science

The College offers students an Elective subject under Bachelor of Arts in Political Science.

Schools are eligible for admission to B.A. 1st year course only if their result is shown as "Pass" in their certificate issued by the said Open Schools and they have obtained the requisite percentage of marks prescribed under the University Regulations for admission to the concerned course. In case their result has not been shown as "Pass" in the relevant column of the said certificate they being ineligible will not be admitted.

Candidates from the Board that are not recognized by Panjab University will not be allowed admission.

Subject Combinations

Every student is required to study two compulsory subjects and three elective subjects.

Compulsory Subjects

1. English
2. Punjabi/ History and Culture of Punjab:
Only the following students may take up History and Culture of Punjab in place of Punjabi Compulsory:
 - a. Candidates who are not domicile of Punjab and have not studied Punjabi at Matriculation or 10+2 level either as an

failing which the Degree will not be issued.

Elective Subjects

A student is required to select any three elective subjects of 2 credits each, selecting not more than one subject from any of the following sets of combinations:

- English/Hindi/Punjabi
- Physical Education/ Psychology
- Home Science/ Public Administration
- Economics/Fine Arts
- Music (Instrumental)
- Political Science
- Functional English
- Sociology/ Computer Science
- History

Students cannot opt for more than two practical subjects. The candidate will have to pass in theory and practical(s) separately.

Change of Subjects

Panjab University allows to change a subject in circumstances in the even semester examination whereas he/she will have to clear that subject as deficient in lower semester examination which he/she has changed in the higher semester for qualifying the award of
