Affiliated to Panjab University, Chandigarh, the College offers Graduate and Post-Graduate courses in Arts, Commerce, Computer Science

and Applications and Science. A total number of 1969 students were enrolled in the current session for different programmes of study.

Infrastructure

The 11 acre of sprawling campus is replete with an expanse of infrastructure which includes all the latest facilities, well-equipped labs, smart class rooms, air-conditioned well-stocked Library, Research Centre, Mata Kheevi Hostel, Seminar Room, Mata Ganga Auditorium, Mata Gujri Fitness Centre, Student's Centre, expansive grounds, etc. Laboratories in Physics and Chemistry Departments boast of latest equipment and resources. The College ensures that learning resources are made available to the students to develop their proficiency in academics. Advanced learners are provided with extra reference books/material by the teachers who set suitable goals before them so that the students feel adequately challenged. The Students' Centre is housed with Stationery Shop, Photostat Facility, and Student Council Office. Also located in the College is a fully functional SBI Branch exclusively for the benefit

of students and College employees. Lending a panoramic view, the landscape garden set near the main building with smooth lawns and beds of perennials augment the beauty of the campus. Providing the right ambience for the young scholars to bloom in the perfect environment, this is the **Best Maintained College campus in Chandigarh.**



Library

In the process of providing quality education to its students, the College makes continuous efforts to enhance its infrastructure in order to facilitate effective teaching-learning practices. The library with its modern infrastructure is being handled by Ms Sukhdeep Kaur, Librarian along with her dedicated team members. The young enthusiastic staff works tirelessly towards the smooth functioning of the library.

The College Library has a Blog (ggscwlibrary.blogspot.in), a digital space for students to access question papers from previous years, pages/links of College activities, achievements of staff and students. Newspapers clippings, latest Panjab University syllabus, links to e-Journals and e-Books are also provided on the blog. The Library provides an **Open Access System**, making it an ideal place for the users to expand their knowledge. Well stocked, with more than **24,200 books and 490+ CDs** on different subjects, the collection is enriched with Reference Books, Coffee Table Books, light reading books like Fiction, Self-help, Biographies of eminent personalities, etc. 38 Magazines/Journals as well as 12 Newspapers are also subscribed by the Library on annual basis. Library homes a **Book Bank** that consist of more than 1800 books on

different subjects, which are lent out for full session to the needy as well as meritorious students. To display the fresh arrivals, The Library has a display stand in the Library and an LED for highlighting the services of the Library along with the new arrivals. **KHOJ: The Wall Magazine** showcases the creative works of the students as well as the activities undertaken by various departments of the College.

Library is fully automated with **Campus Whizz ERP** software equipped with Web OPAC facility, through which users can search their required documents anytime and from anywhere. A striking feature of the library is **Learning Resource Centre** on the first floor, where students have an added facility for their research oriented activities. The Library has a **Braille Corner**, where NVDA (Non Visual Digital Access) software has been installed for blind students. The College has subscribed to e-Journals under the scheme of **NLIST** programme of INFLIBNET, UGC.

There is a separate Reading Room for students to read their personal documents/books. Each Year, the students enrolled in the College are oriented towards Library services and facilities. In the session 2019-2020, the orientation was held from August 5- 9, 2019.

College Hostel

The College has a well-equipped Hostel offering accommodation to 350 residents and catering to four SES institutions. There is a Gurudwara Sahib within the Hostel premises, which offers sanctum

to students. Periodic renovation of the Hostel is undertaken to ensure comfort and hygiene levels to the residents. Facilities like laundry, Common Room, Visitors' Room and LCDs are provided.

Scholarships and Concessions

Students of the College are constantly motivated for attaining excellence in the University examinations through various incentive schemes such as scholarships, fee concessions, Roll of honour and prizes. The College provides remedial classes to motivate the weaker students. Students from socially and economically weaker section are given financial aid, which subsequently leads to their academic growth. The College grants various scholarships received from Directorate of Higher Education - Chandigarh, College Development Council-Panjab University, Chandigarh, Directorate of Social Welfare, Jammu and Kashmir, Directorate of Social Welfare, Manipur, Post Matric Scholarship Scheme Minorities,

Central scheme of scholarship for College and University Students sponsored by Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Government of India (SC), Hindustan Petroleum Scholarship and Post Matric Scholarship for students with Disabilities. The scholarship amount received during the last session was Rs. 5,68,790/-. Several Philanthropists also contributed around Rs. 71,200/- towards the education of economically weaker students of the College. A Special Award of Rs. 25,000/- instituted by the family of Mrs. RK Shergill (Founder Principal) which is given to meritorious and needy students in recognition of all-round excellence for the academic session.

RUSA REPORT 2019-20

The College received a grant of Rs 50 lakhs under the RUSA Scheme from the Department of Higher Education, Chandigarh for utilization under the heads of renovation, upgradation and purchase of equipment. Plans were made for the optimum utilization of funds but the execution of the planned activities could not be done due to Covid -19 pandemic.

Some of the planned activities were executed, like the purchase of equipment which included laptops, antivirus software, LED flood lights for the multifunctional playground, a lawn mowing machine for the College garden, and cloth drying stands for the hostel. The refurbishment of the parking area has been done which was in very bad shape and was causing inconvenience to the staff and students especially during rainy season. It has been planned to upgrade the Multi-purpose Hall of the College by installing false ceiling, ACs and the tile terracing of the roof. The upgradation of the hall will help in convenient and smooth execution of events and optimum utilization of the hall even during summer season. Fire fighting equipment will be installed in the College library for the safety and security of the library resources as well as of staff and students. Sports equipments are also to be acquired as per the requirements of the Sports department so as to meet the needs of



sports students without any delay. Upgradation of classrooms is also to be done related with needed repair work and installation of additional fans to make the teaching and learning more comfortable. UPS will also be procured for the smart classrooms and labs to ensure better performance.

Renovation of the hostel is also in the list for the convenience of hostel students and to make their stay more comfortable. Washrooms and toilets are to be refurbished as per the requirement of the students; the old furniture for the mess will be changed with the new furniture. Air conditioners, additional wardrobes and water coolers are also to be acquired for the hostellers.

The open area near the stage will also be beautified and sitting areas will be created for the students. More wi-fi access points will be installed to provide better internet facility to the staff and students. These plans will be executed as soon as the life is back on the track.


A Slogan Writing Competition on Cleanliness for the volunteers of NSS was organised in the college on February 04, 2020 to sensitize them about value of cleanliness.


On February 04, 2020 **World Cancer Day** was celebrated by holding a quiz and screening a documentary to raise awareness about cancer
