Academic Courses

Affiliated to Panjab University, Chandigarh, the College offers Post Graduate Courses in Commerce, Economics and English; Undergraduate Courses in Commerce, Sciences (Non-Med/ Comp Sc), Computer Science & Applications and Humanities. A total number of 1913 students were enrolled in the current session for different programmes of study.

Infrastructure

The 11 acres of sprawling campus is replete with an expanse of infrastructure which includes the latest facilities with threestoreyed Arts, Science and Commerce Blocks with spacious and well-equipped Classrooms and Smart Classrooms. A ramp connects all blocks to the ground floor offering easy access to physically disabled.

The College has well-equipped laboratories in the Departments of Physics, Chemistry, Computer Science, Functional English, Psychology, Home Science, Music, and Fine Arts.

The College library is spacious, fully automated with Campus Whizz ERP software, centrally air-conditioned, equipped with INFLIBNET data base. Learning Resource Centre provides facility to students for their research-oriented activities. The library also has a Braille Corner with NVDA (Non-Visual Digital Access) software for visually challenged students.

The College houses a Research Lab., an airconditioned Seminar Room, and Mata Ganga Auditorium. The College boasts of a large sports ground with multipurpose track, Mata Gujri Fitness Centre, an open air gym and expansive grounds for students.

The Students' Centre is housed with Canteencum-Cafeteria, a Stationery Shop along with Photostat Facility.

Also located in the College is a fully functional SBI Branch exclusively for the benefit of students and College employees.

The College takes pride in its landscape gardens set near the main building with smooth lawns and beds of perennials which constantly augment the beauty of the campus. The College has Campus-wide Wi-Fi Facility, 24x7 CCTV Surveillance and 24x7 Power Supply and Generator Facility.

The College campus won the **1st prize at the Annual Rose Festival 2023 in the category of the 'Best Maintained Campus' in Chandigarh,** a feat which the College has been consistently accomplishing since 2008.



College Library

For almost 50 years, the College has been providing quality education to the students and has made continuous efforts to build and enhance its infrastructure in order to facilitate effective teaching-learning practices. The library with modern infrastructure is efficiently handled by Ms Sukhdeep Kaur, Librarian, along with her dedicated team members Mr Jaspreet Singh, Library Assistant and Ms Gagandeep Kaur, Restorer. The young enthusiastic staff is working towards the smooth functioning of the library.

The College Library has a Blog (ggscwlibrary. blogspot.in), adigitalspaceforstudentstoaccess question papers from previous years, pages/ links of various activities and achievements of the staff and students, newspaper clippings, latest Panjab University syllabus, and links to various open access e-resources. During the pandemic COVID-19, the Library initiated **Gyankosh:** an Institutional Repository, where the faculty members contributed their recorded e-lectures in the form of PPts, audio/ video lectures and PDFs, accessible through the Blog. The Library provides an Open Access system, making it an ideal place for the users to expand and widen their knowledge. Well stocked with around 24,400 books and 490+ CDs on different subjects, the collection is enriched with Reference Books, Coffee Table Books, Light Reading Books like Fiction, Selfhelp, Biographies of eminent personalities, etc. Total numbers of 9 magazines and Journals as well as 6 Newspapers are also subscribed to by the Library on annual basis. Library homes the 'Book Bank' that consist of more than 2000 books on different subjects which are lent out for the full session to the needy as well as meritorious students. To display the fresh arrivals, there is a display stand in the Library and an LED for highlighting the services of Library. **KHOJ:** The Wall Magazine show cases the creative works of the students.

Library is fully automated with Campus Whizz ERP software. A striking feature of the library is **Learning Resource Centre** on the first floor, where students have added facility for their research oriented activities. The Library also has a Braille Corner, where one computer with NVDA (Non Visual Digital Access) software for the Blind is installed. The College has subscribed to e-Journals under the scheme of NLIST programme of INFLIBNET, UGC. There is a separate reading room for students to read their personal documents/ books. Each Year the students enrolled in the College are oriented towards Library services and facilities.

Activities

To celebrate the 50 Golden Years of College and cherish the works of Indian authors, the College Library has formed a Storytelling Club **'Literary Birds: The Flight of Fantasy'.** The club organised a series of sessions throughout the year. Faculty and students participated and explored the magical world of stories.

The College Library in collaboration with Department of Fine Arts organised a **Poster Making Competition** on the theme **'Importance of Books**' on March 20, 2023. 20 Students participated. Athulya, BA II, won the first prize, second prize was bagged by Shweta, BA II and Aarzoo of BA II won the third prize.

College Hostel

The College has a well-equipped Hostel offering accommodation to 300 residents and catering to four SES institutions. There is a Gurudwara Sahib within the Hostel premises, which offers sanctum to students. Periodic renovation of the Hostel is undertaken to ensure comfort and hygiene levels to the residents. Facilities like laundry, Common Room, Visitors' Room and LCDs are provided.



Scholarships and Concessions

The students of the College are constantly motivated for attaining excellence in the University Examinations through various incentive schemes such as scholarships, fee concessions, Roll of honour and prizes. In this session, too, sports students were given huge concessions. A sum of Rs. 13,92,136/- was given as College fee concession and Rs.16.3 lakhs was given as Hostel Fee concession.

TheCellorganisedan On-Campus Placement Drive from March 27-29, 2023. The drive was conducted successfully with several reputed companies visiting the College campus. On day one, companies such as NYX India Operations, eClerks Services Ltd, and Piramal Housing Finance Limited visited the College campus for placement. The selection process for eClerks Services Ltd included an HR round, assessment round, and telephonic interviews. **Piramal Housing Finance Limited distributed** Offer Letters to 46 selected candidates. 207 students registered on the first day and around 100 students were successfully placed on the first day with different companies. On the second day, companies like Touchstone Educationals LLP, Fusion, and NYX India operations visited the College Campus for the Placement Drive. In order to select candidates, the companies conducted Aptitude tests, screening followed by interviews. 151 students registered for the drive and around 60 students were selected. On last day of the Drive, companies such as IFM Fincoach, Yes Bank, Axis bank, UCode Soft Solutions, Virtual Oplossing, hitBullsEye visited the campus. The companies conducted various aptitude tests, interviews and several other assessment rounds. More than half of the total students who registered were selected.
