It combines theoretical instruction with practical training, including boat pulling, sailing, and ship modeling, thereby offering a balanced blend of knowledge and hands-on experience. The wing has a total strength of 34 cadets and the wing is led by CTO, Dr Kamalpreet Kaur from PG Department of English.

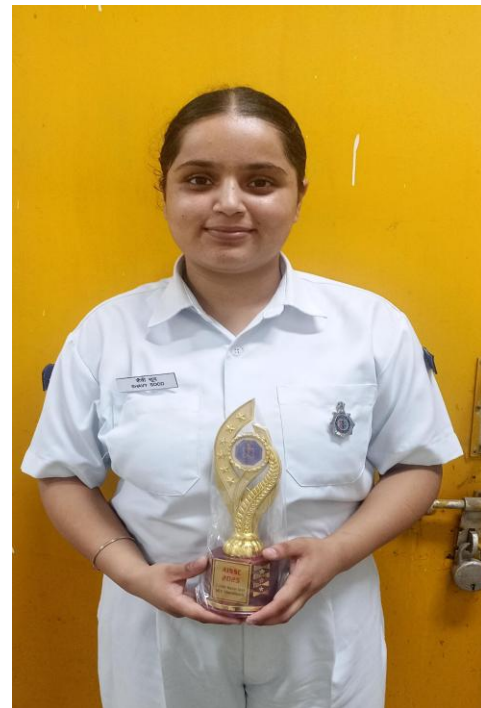
The various activities undertaken by NCC Naval Wing are outlined as follows:

- NCC Naval Cadets and CTO Dr Kamalpreet Kaur attended the lecture on National Mission to Eliminate Sickle Cell Anaemia on July 25, 2025 at NCC Naval Unit, Sector 31, Chandigarh.
